Workshop Two – Layering and Texture

For those who have attended An Introduction to Felting or those who are practised in wet-felting methods. You will explore how to use layering techniques and how to create different textures to produce a stunning picture/felt hanging.

Workshops One and Two use the reverse method and will include; cutting glass and unglazed ceramic, using moulds to cast in grout, fixing and finishing your piece to take home.

Workshop Three - Decorate a Plant Pot or Tile

Workshop three utilises the direct method; covering use of preshaped glass, cutting glass tessera, adhesive & grout handling and cleaning/finishing.

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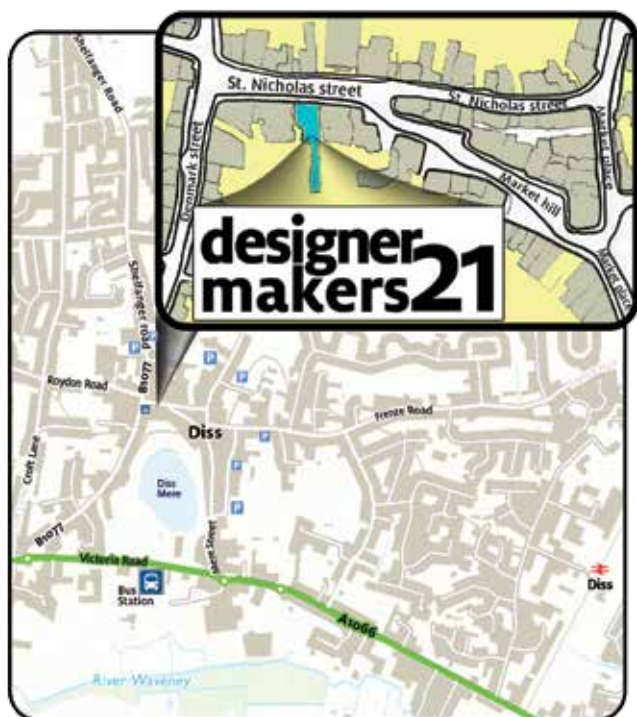
